



#### SAMMY THE SEAL HAD TWO BROTHERS.




ONE WAS CALLED SIMON

#### HIS BROTHERS TRIED TO ENCOURAGE HIM TO SWIM WITH THEM.




## BUT POOR SAMMY COULD ONLY PLAY IN THE SHALLOW WATER.

# ONE DAY HIS MOTHER TOLD HIM, "TO FIND FOOD THE WHOLE FAMILY MUST SWIM TOGETHER."




### THE SOUTH OF THE ISLAND WAS WHERE THE FISH GATHERED AROUND THIS TIME OF YEAR.

TO FOLLOW THE FAMILY.




#### NEARBY WAS A LITTLE FISHING VILLAGE.

#### ONE DAY THERE WAS A BIG STORM.




#### SAMMY SAW THE FISHERMEN'S SMALL BOAT OVERTURN IN THE MIGHTY WIND.

#### SAMMY THEN PLUCKED UP ALL HIS COURAGE AND SWAM OUT TOWARDS THE MEN.






# WHEN HE REACHED THE MEN HE CARRIED THEM TO SHORE ON HIS BACK.
